Dress code

Registration

The registration desk for the Conference will be located in the foyer on the Boulevard Level. You must collect your registration pack upon your arrival at the venue.

Name Badges

Name badges must be worn at all times for access into the Conference sessions and catering areas. Nametags must be retained for the duration of your visit to the Conference.

Please note: All delegates and Sunday ticket holders are entitled to 20% food and beverages at Bacchus Restaurant (Rydges) for Sunday 2nd of February 2014! (Note this special can only be redeemed on Sunday, by showing your registration name badge or Sunday event ticket)

Lunches

Lunches and refreshment breaks will be taken in the foyer space on the Boulevard Level.

Messages for delegates

Messages for delegates can be left at the registration desk where it will be written on paper and pinned to the message board or kept in a message box. Please check for messages regularly as sessions will not be interrupted for individual messages. Registration staff are not responsible for ensuring the messages reach the person.

Transport options to the venue

- Central city location: 10 minutes walk to CBD
- Cultural Centre Busway: 5 minutes walk
- South Brisbane Train Station: adjacent to Centre on Grey Street, with direct Air Train service
- Designated taxi rank Merivale Street Main Entrance, taxi drop off area at Grey Street Entrance
- Russell Walk connecting pedestrians between Merivale and Grey Street.



From the airport to the venue

By Train: The closest train station is South Brisbane; only a few minutes walk away. A regular Air Train service operates between Brisbane's international and domestic airports. Travelling time is approximately 25mins. Tickets are available from the Information Desk in the airport and the ticket machines at the train station.

Taxis: Ample taxis are available from the airport and travel time is around 25 minutes to the venue in non-peak conditions.

Brisbane weather

Parking

The Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre has parking available in the multi-storey car park, entry via Grey Street, Merivale Street and Melbourne Street, South Brisbane. The car park is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The charge is a maximum of \$25.00 per day (after four hours). This is payable on entry. Limited street parking is available close to the Convention Centre, but these areas are heavily patrolled, so stick to the time limit or expect a ticket! Special dietary requirements

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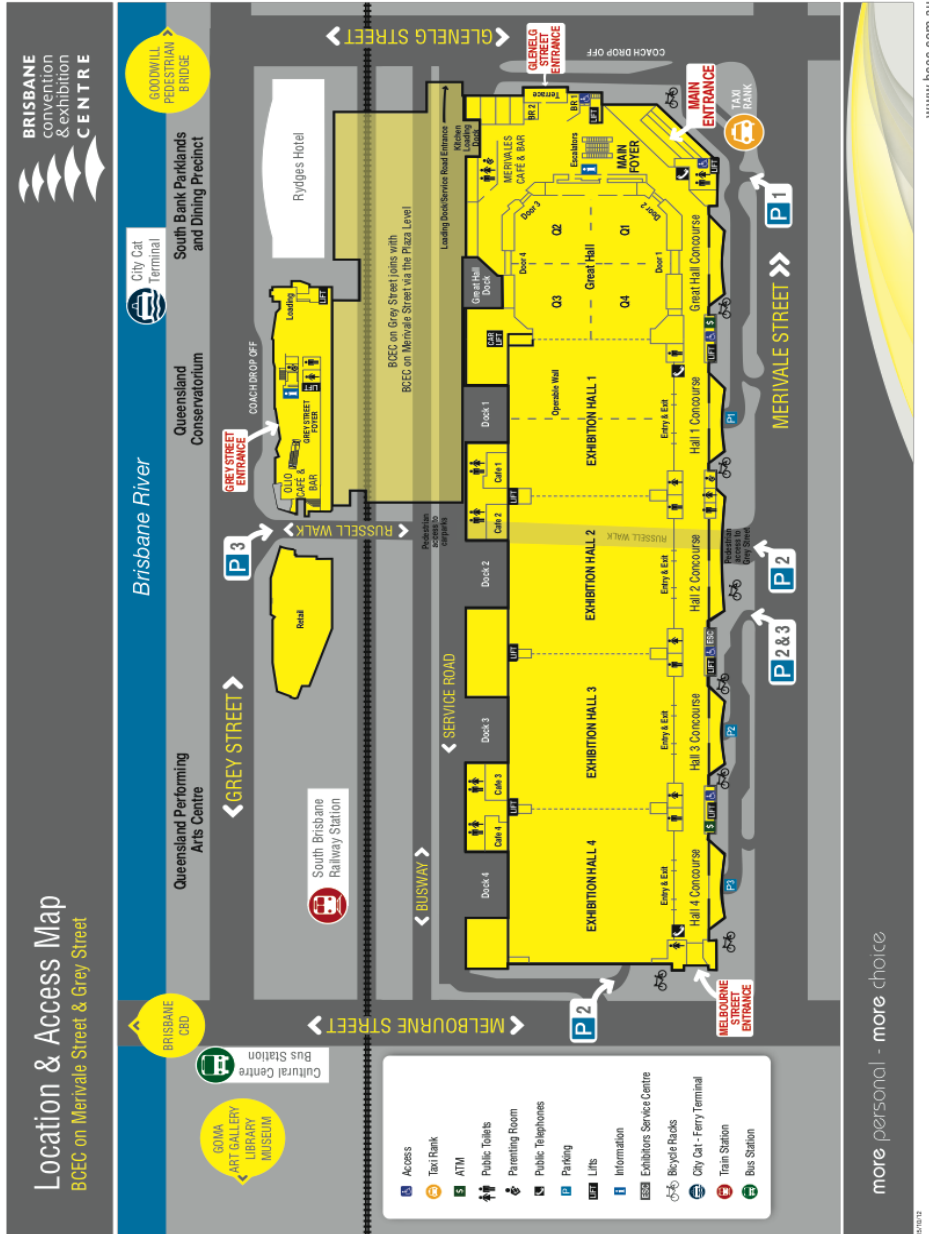
